

Film Production Grant Offers \$75k For Mental Health Shorts

Voices With Impact will award 10 filmmaking teams \$7.5k to create transformative 5 minute films

August 15, 2023: Art With Impact has announced that for a 6th year, their short film production grant, Voices With Impact, will award 10 filmmaking teams \$7.5k to create 5 minute films on specific underrepresented mental health topics. For 2024, the grant calls for proposals on Serious Mental Illness and Cliques & Echo Chambers. The grant is open globally and the deadline to submit a proposal is Midnight, PT, September 17, 2023.

“As a filmmaker, finding the space to share your authentic stories can be difficult—Voices With Impact champions impactful fresh narratives. Voices With Impact is looking to fund 5 new short films telling authentic stories of people living with serious mental illnesses and 5 new short films that shed light on the disconnections in society and the profound effect this can have on mental health.

Voices With Impact is a global film production grant and festival that elevates underrepresented mental health narratives. The grant program annually funds ten filmmakers to create influential short films on various mental health topics. The Mental Health Services Oversight & Accountability Commission supports the grant program. These films premiere at the festival, in June, inciting engaging dialogues and discussions that foster a deep comprehension of societal mental health issues.
